5.8 Kununoppin St John Ambulance Sub-Centre

- New ambulance for Kununoppin arrived just before Christmas and is about to go on the road
- Beacon will get the old van for a spare
- Another van coming for July for Kununoppin
- Beacon will get the Kununoppin van as their main van
- Have two new Volunteers for Trayning
 Can now team up Its working well with Kununoppin and Trayning
- A recent incident in one of the vans identified that the that Duress did not work as it should of and we commend the Police for their prompt action for getting to us for help.
- As a result extra phones have been put in Vans with Duress alarm systems for Officers safety.
- With the reduction in the 3G network we have lost about 1/3 of our coverage.
- We will trial a couple of booster kits and are looking at other systems

- All our uniforms should be updated around May
- Transfers are tending to go more Northam than Merredin now.

- HSM also attending 2 day IMT training 3 4/04/2025
- Hospital staff have been attending in house training exercises for fire and Safety.
- Hospital grounds very difficult to keep free of bark and leaves at present.
 Workcamp prisoners assisting.
